

George Alexander Elliott was born in Newry, Armagh Co. Ireland in the year 1784. After serving his apprenticeship as a weaver, he with several others left their native land for the United States. On his arrival in New York, he was pressed and taken on board a Man of War. At the expiration of his term, he went to Halifax, Nova Scotia and there he joined the Nova Scotia Fencibles, in which service he remained about twelve years, when peace was proclaimed and he was discharged.

He then got a grant of land in the western part of Lunenburg Co. Nova Scotia, which was afterwards named Sherbrooke. He married Susannah Bezanson (Besancon) on August 7, 1823. He left Sherbrooke in 1855 and went to Cornwallis, Nova Scotia in which place he lived five years. He then went to live with his daughter where he spent the remainder of his life. He died January 2, 1864. He was brought up in the Presbyterian faith and was a deacon in the church in Sherbrooke.

He married Susannah Bezanson on 7 Aug 1823 at St. Stephen's Anglican Church in Chester, Nova Scotia. She was the daughter of Gideon Bezanson (1783-1818) and Mary Pulsifer (1789-1854).

He died 2 Jan 1864 in Lunenburg, Lunenburg County, Nova Scotia
